

The Theodore Roosevelt Medal celebrates the impact of Theodore Roosevelt on Scouting in Nassau County. The requirements for the medal reflect and lifelong interest in conservation, civic service, personal fitness, and his personal history as a founding leader of America Scouting.

#### KEY MEDAL REQUIREMENTS

**RECOGNITION OF ACHIEVEMENT IN CONSERVATION** (a key theme of the TR presidency): Scout Oath and Law - Thrifty and Helpful

**RECOGNITION OF ACHIEVEMENT IN COMMUNITY SERVICE** (in recognition of TR and his dedication to Nassau County scouting) Scout Oath - “to help other people at all times”.

**RECOGNITION OF ACHIEVEMENT IN PERSONAL FITNESS** (in recognition of his lifelong celebration of “the strenuous life” Scout Oath - “to keep myself physical strong”

**RECOGNITION OF ACTIVITIES SPECIFIC TO SAGAMORE HILL, THE TR RESIDENCE & NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE** or service elsewhere in the National Park System, a legacy of the Roosevelt presidency. of Scouting in Nassau County.

BOY SCOUT REQUIREMENTS



Theodore Roosevelt was a key founder of the Nassau County Council (now the Theodore Roosevelt Council). He was the first Council Commissioner, and the only Chief Scout Citizen named by the Boy Scouts of America. The Theodore Roosevelt Medal is recognition of TR's impact on Scouting by celebrating the individual achievement of youth and leaders who earn specific BSA awards that celebrate conservation, community service, personal fitness, and activities specific to Sagamore Hill, the TR residence and National Historic Site in our council or National Park Service sites.

Boy Scouts can earn the award. The completed requirements are submitted with an advancement report to the Theodore Roosevelt Council Service Center for review and processing. Please provide payment for the medal with the submission of the requirements – the cost of the medal is \$ 15.00.
